General Exhibit Requirements

Project check-in: Bring your exhibit to the fairgrounds on Monday, August 10, 2020 between 5-8pm.

Project check-out times are:

Supervised - Sunday, August 16, 2020 from 7-8pm

Unsupervised - Sunday, August 16, 2020 from 8-9pm

Monday, August 17, 2020 during the day, after that projects will be at the
 Extension Office until September 18.

1. Project books and Member Project Guides are required at all judgings. If book is absent, grade will be lowered and member is not eligible to place.
2. Appropriate attire for judging will be required. Appearance should be neat, clean, and respectful. No shorts, tank tops, tube tops, halter tops, midriff tops, or low rise jeans should be worn for judging.
3. All projects displayed at the fair must be identified with name, age, and project. Display must be for the current year's project.
4. Junior division includes ages 13 and younger. Senior division includes ages 14 and older as of January 1 of that judging year. If numbers in a project warrant it, the junior class will be split to include a Beginner class.

✓ **750 Rifle REVISED 2020**- Members taking this project should purchase book #630 in addition to book #750-. Book #630 provides basic subject matter information and safety. Members are expected to provide their own safety equipment. Bring to judging your shooting record book and your fair exhibit. **To attend judging and be eligible to place, you must attend at least 4 shoots with the instructors and get your book signed!** Be prepared to share your knowledge with the judge. *Fair Exhibit* can be a 22"x28" poster; scrap book on one of the following topics: safe shooting procedures, shooting and safety equipment, a shooting competition you participated in; or a topic of your choice comparable to those listed.

***Guns, bows, arrows, ammunition, and weapons are not permitted on the fairgrounds and therefore should not be a part of your exhibit.

✓ **751 Archery REVISED 2020**- Members taking this project should purchase book #631 in addition to book #751. Book #631 provides basic subject matter information. Members are expected to provide their own safety equipment for shoots. This includes: arm guard, fingertip protection and safety glasses. Bring to judging your shooting record book and your fair exhibit. **To attend judging and be eligible to place, you must attend at least 4 shoots with the instructors and get your book signed!** Be prepared to share your knowledge with the judge. *Fair Exhibit* can be a 22"x28" poster; scrap book on one of the following topics: safe shooting procedures, shooting and safety equipment, a shooting competition you participated in; or a topic of your choice comparable to those listed.

Cross bows are prohibited.

***Guns, bows, arrows, ammunition, and weapons are not permitted on the fairgrounds and therefore should not be a part of your exhibit.
