Evaluation Times & Places

Projects will be judged Tuesday, July 21st after 5 pm at the Erie Co. Fairgrounds. Specific judging times for each project will be posted on our website in July.

Announcement of results will begin after 7:00pm.

General Exhibit Requirements

Project check-in: Bring your exhibit to the fairgrounds on Monday, August 10, 2020 between 5-8pm.

Project check-out times are:

Supervised - Sunday, August 16, 2020 from 7-8pm

Unsupervised - Sunday, August 16, 2020 from 8-9pm

Monday, August 17, 2020 during the day, after that projects will be at the Extension Office until September 18

1. Project books and Member Project Guides are required at all judgings. If book is absent, grade will be lowered and member is not eligible to place.
2. Appropriate attire for judging will be required. Appearance should be neat, clean, and respectful. No shorts, tank tops, tube tops, halter tops, midriff tops, or low rise jeans should be worn for judging.
3. All projects displayed at the fair must be identified with name, age, and project. Displays must be for the current year's project.
4. Junior division includes ages 13 and younger. Senior division includes ages 14 and older as of January 1 of that judging year. If numbers in a project warrant it, the junior class will be split to include a Beginner class.

555 ATV Safety - You must have access to your own ATV and protective gear. Bring completed project book and display to judging. Follow the member project guide on page 5 of your book. The completion requirements are listed as steps 1 – 4 on page 5. Be sure to do the project summary listed in step 4. Exhibit a poster or a display on a topic you learned in your project not to exceed 30"x30" about your project.

*Junior Fair projects may not be sold on the fairgrounds except through the fair project auctions.
 For sale signs may not be posted on projects.
