Evaluation Times & Places

Projects will be judged Tuesday, July 21st after 5 pm at the Erie Co. Fairgrounds. Specific judging times for each project will be posted on our website in July.

Announcement of results will begin after 7:00pm.

General Exhibit Requirements

Project check-in: Bring your exhibit to the fairgrounds on Monday, August 10, 2020 between 5-8pm.

Project check-out times are:

Supervised - Sunday, August 16, 2020 from 7-8pm

Unsupervised - Sunday, August 16, 2020 from 8-9pm

Monday, August 17, 2020 during the day, after that projects will be at the Extension Office until September 18.

1. Completed project books and Member Project Guides are required at all judgings. If book is absent, grade will be lowered and the member is not eligible to place.
2. Appropriate attire for judging is required. Appearance should be neat, clean, and respectful. No shorts, tank tops, tube tops, halter tops, midriff tops, or low rise jeans should be worn for judging or for the small project auction.
3. All projects displayed at the fair must be identified with name, age, and project. Displays must be for the current year's project.
4. Junior division includes ages 13 and younger. Senior division includes ages 14 and older as of January 1 of that judging year. If numbers in a project warrant it, the junior class will be split to include a beginner class. 14 year olds will stay with Senior Class.

☐ Denotes Small Project Auction Eligibility for first place winners. 4-H'er must make the sale item and it must relate to the project. Read Small Project Auction Rules. **Sign up by Friday, August 7, 2020.**

No checks from the Livestock Sale or the Small Project Auction will be mailed! All checks will need to be picked up at the Erie County Fair Sr. Fairboard Office on Saturday, October 17, 2020 from 9am to 1pm. Checks can be picked up by the exhibitor or immediate family member with a valid form of ID. If the exhibitor or an immediate family member cannot pick up, anyone presenting a signed letter from the exhibitor or the exhibitor's legal guardian can pick up the check. All checks will require a signature of the person picking up the check. All sale checks must be cashed by November 25th of the current year or funds are forfeited. This includes issued checks and checks held for not meeting requirements, i.e. Thank you notes or poultry cards not submitted. No exceptions allowed.

✓ **592 Get Started in Art** - Bring completed project book and two art projects from any of the interest areas or an area of your choice to judging. The two projects do not have to be from the same interest area. Follow the Member Project Guidelines on pages 5-7 of the book and record the completion of tasks on those pages. Be sure to do the activities and questions throughout the book. Fair exhibit may not exceed 36"x36".

If you are chosen for state fair participation, state fair requires a piece of art work AND a display that represents your learning experience.

***Exhibitors may not use projects which were made for school.

✓ **593 – Seeing Through Graphic Design**- Bring completed project book, portfolio and display to judging. Follow the project guidelines on page 3 for completing the book. Be sure to record your progress on pages 3-6 of your book. In addition, complete the exercises through-out the book. Develop your portfolio by following activity 10 "Create a Portfolio." Your display should represent a learning experience from your project and not exceed a space of 36" high by 48" wide. This is the maximum trifold display board you may use, but you don't have to use a tri-fold display, you may do something else that conforms to those size limits.

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*Junior Fair projects may not be sold on the fairgrounds except through the fair project auctions.
For sale signs may not be posted on projects.
