Evaluation, Times & Places

Projects will be judged Tuesday, July 21st after 5pm at the Erie Co. Fairgrounds. Specific judging times for each project will be posted on our website in July.

Announcement of results will begin after 7pm.

General Information

Project check-in: Bring your exhibit to the fairgrounds on Monday, August 10, 2020 between 5-8pm.

Project check-out times are:

Supervised - Sunday, August 16, 2020 from 7-8pm

Unsupervised - Sunday, August 16, 2020 from 8-9pm

Monday, August 17, 2020 during the day, after that projects will be at the Extension Office until September 18.

SCRAPBOOKING GUIDELINES

All scrapbooking projects at State Fair will be judged on Creative Arts Day.

- 4-H members should bring to judging a completed project book with their fair exhibit. Completed project book and project guides are required at all judgings. If book and/or guidelines are not complete or not present, the letter grade will be lowered and the member is not eligible to place.
- Appropriate attire for judging will be required. Appearance should be neat, clean, and respectful. No shorts, tank tops, tube tops, halter tops, midriff tops, or low rise jeans should be worn for judging.
- Do not bring project books for fair display! We only have room to display the projects.
- Junior division includes ages 13 and younger. Senior division includes ages 14 and older as of January 1 of that judging year. For county judging, if numbers in the project warrant it, each division will be split.

Designates projects that are eligible for the state fair, if member is selected.

Denotes Small Project Auction Eligibility for first place winners. 4-H'er must make the sale item and it must relate to the project. Read Small Project Auction Rules. **Sign up by Friday, August 7, 2020.**

No checks from the Livestock Sale or the Small Project Auction will be mailed! All checks will need to be picked up at the Erie County Fair Sr. Fairboard Office on Saturday, October 17, 2020 from 9am to 1pm. Checks can be picked up by the exhibitor or immediate family member with a valid form of ID. If the exhibitor or an immediate family member cannot pick up, anyone presenting a signed letter from the exhibitor or the exhibitor's legal guardian can pick up the check. All checks will require a signature of the person picking up the check. All sale checks must be cashed by November 25th of the current year or funds are forfeited. This includes issued checks and checks held for not meeting requirements, i.e. Thank you notes or poultry cards not submitted. No exceptions allowed.

✂️ 497 **Scrapbooking: A 4-H Guide to Preserving Memories** - This beginner/intermediate level project is designed for youth with limited experiences in Scrapbooking. Using the information contained in the project book can also be useful when making presentations for other 4-H projects.

Judging: Complete a scrapbook with a theme of your choice for judging and display at fair. Bring your completed project book including the completion of seven activities, two Learning Experiences, two Leadership/Citizenship activities. Judging also includes a scrapbook evaluation, and skill-a-thon.

Fair exhibit: Single page from scrapbook.

You cannot use your scrapbook in conjunction with any other 4-H project or a school project.

*Junior Fair projects may not be sold on the fairgrounds except through the fair project auctions.
For sale signs may not be posted on projects.
