Projects will be judged Tuesday, July 21st after 5pm at the Erie Co. Fairgrounds. Specific judging times for each project will be posted on our website in July.

General Exhibit Requirements

Project check-in: Bring your exhibit to the fairgrounds on Monday, August 10, 2020 between 5-8pm.

Project check-out times are:

Supervised - Sunday, August 16, 2020 from 7-8pm

Unsupervised - Sunday, August 16, 2020 from 8-9pm

Monday, August 17, 2020 during the day, after that projects will be at the Extension Office until September 18.

1. Completed project books and Member Project Guides are required at all judgings. If book and/or guidelines are not complete or not present, the letter grade will be lowered and the member is not eligible to place.
2. Appropriate attire for judging will be required. Appearance should be neat, clean, and respectful. No shorts, tank tops, tube tops, halter tops, midriff tops, or low rise jeans should be worn for judging or for the small project auction.
3. All projects displayed at the fair must be identified with name, age, and project. Display must be for the current year's project.
4. Junior division includes ages 13 and younger, senior division includes ages 14 and older as of January 1 of this year. If numbers in a project warrant it, the junior class will be split to include a Beginner class.

✓ **551 Tractor 1: Starting Up** – Bring completed project book along with a project exhibit to judging. Be sure to complete all activities in the project book, documenting the completion of each activity on page 4 of the project book. *Fair exhibit* should demonstrate something you have learned in completing the project. It could be a poster on a topic from the book or an educational display not to exceed 36"x36"x36".

✓ **552 Tractor 2: Gearing Up for Safety** – Bring completed project book along with a project exhibit to judging. Be sure to complete all activities in the project book, documenting the completion of each activity on page 4 of the project book. *Fair exhibit* should demonstrate something you have learned in completing the project. It could be a poster on a topic from the book or an educational display not to exceed 36"x36"x36".

✓ **553 Tractor 3: Moving Out** – Bring completed project book along with a project exhibit to judging. Be sure to complete all activities in the project book, documenting the completion of each activity on page 4 of the project book. *Fair exhibit* should demonstrate something you have learned in completing the project. It could be a poster on a topic from the book or an educational display not to exceed 36"x36"x36".

✓ **551 Tractor 4: Learning More** – Bring completed project book along with a project exhibit to judging. Be sure to complete all activities in the project book, documenting the completion of each activity on page 4 of the project book. *Fair exhibit* should demonstrate something you have learned in completing the project. It could be a poster on a topic from the book or an educational display not to exceed 36"x36"x36".

State Fair Competition: The state competition for tractors is **NOT** at the State Fairgrounds it's held in London, Ohio at AgPro Ohio Equipment. Please review the details carefully. Participants will take a written test, complete a parts identification test and be asked to drive a tractor. State Fair classes are divided by age not tractor project level.

*Junior Fair projects may not be sold on the fairgrounds except through the fair project auctions.
For sale signs may not be posted on projects.
