

2024 Erie County 4-H Camp Rules

1. Be respectful and show kindness to everyone by including everyone.
2. Report all sickness and injuries to the nurse at once. The camp nurse will dispense all medications. No medication is kept in the cabin. Prescription medications must be brought in their original container.
3. Do not go to the beach without a lifeguard or during non-waterfront activities.
4. Respect others and their property. Use language and manners that are respectful.
5. No Fighting.
6. Everyone must be in their cabin and quiet by lights out, and remain there until 6:30am. **Quiet hours are from lights out until 8:00am.** If you are someplace other than in your cabin, the bathroom, or the nurse's station after lights out, you will be sent home.
7. A raised hand means to listen. When you see someone with a raised hand, you also raise your hand, are quiet, and listen for instructions.
8. Shoes must be worn at all times, except when showering, sleeping, or swimming. Shoes must be worn when going from the cabins to showers and when going to the beach.
9. No hats are to be worn during flag ceremony or meals. Shirts must be worn in the dining hall and over bathing suits.
10. State Law prohibits possession of drugs, alcoholic beverages, tobacco, tobacco products, firearms, hunting knives and other weapons as well as firecrackers and fireworks at camp. Possession of such items will result in your immediate separation from the camp program, and you will be required to call your parents/guardian and arrange transportation home.
11. There shall be no materials including print, music, or clothing brought to camp of a profane nature. The Camp Director will confiscate such materials.
12. Girls are not to be in Boys cabins and Boys are not to be in Girls cabins; if this is not followed you will be sent home.
13. Campers are not permitted to leave camp without the permission of the Camp Director and their parent/guardian except for emergency or medical treatment.
14. No visitors are permitted at camp without the approval of the Camp Director.
15. Attend all activities and meals when the bell is rung. No one should be in cabins during activities or meals.
16. There is to be no littering, if you are caught littering you will be asked to pick up litter around camp.
17. Animals in the wildlife shelter are to be handled only with the permission of the Nature Leader. No other wildlife should be handled.
18. Campers may not be at the Gaga Ball Pit without a counselor to supervise.
19. **Campers are NOT permitted to have cell phones at camp.** If a camper is found with a cell phone, the phone will be confiscated until the end of camp. Campers are not permitted to use the camp phone to call home. Parents will be contacted by the adult camp staff if there is an emergency.
