General Information

Fair Entry Deadline – Entries via FairEntry Online System due by July 14th at 11:59 p.m.

Project check-in: Bring your exhibit to the fairgrounds on **Sunday, August 3, 2025**, between 5-8pm.

Project check-out:

Sunday, August 10, 2025, **9am-NOON**.

Please plan to help tear down project building at 12 noon.

Projects will be at the Extension Office Monday, August 11 until September 15, 2025.

PROJECTS GUIDELINES

1. 4-H members should bring to judging a completed project book with their fair exhibit. Complete the "Project Guide" section and at least the minimum activities. Completed project book and project guides are required at all judgings. If book and/or guidelines are not complete or not present, the letter grade will be lowered, and the member is not eligible to place.
2. This project is categorized as an equipment project. The judge will evaluate knowledge and skill of the equipment user.
3. Appropriate attire for judging will be required. Appearance should be neat, clean, and respectful. No shorts, tank tops, tube tops, halter tops, midriff tops, or low-rise jeans should be worn for judging or for the small project auction.

✎ Designates projects that are eligible for the state fair if the member is selected.

✎ **405 – The Laundry Project** - Designed as a one-time experience for members. Complete the Member's Project Guide on pages 1 and 2, including the one-page report. *Judging & Fair Exhibit:* Exhibit illustrating highlights of your project experiences/learning or one of the completed learning activities for an educational display. A laundry basket filled with laundry products is not an educational display. You will have a 3'X3'X3' area in which to display your project. Flat poster will not be accepted as an exhibit.

*Junior Fair projects may not be sold on the fairgrounds except through the fair project auctions. For sale signs not allowed.
