How to access and complete online 4-H Volunteer Training.
COMPLETE BY April 28

Step 1 - Download the FIVE handouts needed for training at <https://go.osu.edu/CnUK>
They are located under “**Handouts for online training**” near the bottom of the page.

Step 2 - Complete “2025 Ohio 4-H Youth Activities and Programs Policy Training”

1. Visit the self-registration link at <https://go.osu.edu/YAP>
2. Fill out the registration form. Name and email addresses are required. It is okay to enter “0” for phone number and zip code. Enter “NA” for title and company.
3. After filling out the registration form, you will receive two emails from Canvas Catalog. One email will ask you to complete your registration, the other will confirm your enrollment in your course.
4. After creating your account to complete the required training, bookmark the login page at: <https://scarlet.instructure.com/login/canvas>
5. Complete each module/video of the course and any corresponding quizzes.
 - a. At the end of the course – complete the Certificate of Completion / Course Evaluation survey
 - b. Scarlet sends a copy of the completion certificate to you and your county’s secure mailbox

Step 3 - Complete “2024 4-H Volunteer Training” which has **2 separate modules**.

1. Go to the website <https://edpuzzle.com> or download the Edpuzzle app to complete it on your smartphone.
2. Select “Open Class” on the website or “Enter Open Class code” in the app.
3. Enter class code **husjolf** OR use this direct link <https://edpuzzle.com/join/husjolf>
4. **When prompted to enter a nick name you MUST enter your first and last name to get credit.**
5. Be sure to watch **BOTH** videos (**JustSeth Suicide Prevention Talk and 2025 County Update**) and complete the quizzes that go with the videos.



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
