 Campers will come off ferry and walk to the City of Marblehead Lot (where check in was held)



Part of the child's positive experiences at camp is learning how to get along without family members around. Please do NOT promise your camper that you will come and get them if they want to go home!

Campers may NOT use the camp phone to call home ~ phone calls are reserved for emergency situations ONLY.  
 Cancellation: If for any reason a child who has registered for camp is not able to go, please contact the Extension Office immediately so that we will not expect them at the boat dock.

**To Kelleys Island Ferry Boat**

**Line:** Exit Rt. 2 at 269 North; Take 269 N. to Route 163; Turn Right (East) onto 163; The Kelleys Island Ferry is located at 510 West Main St. (across from the Police Department, and Fire Station.) Village of Marblehead lot located on your left just before you go under the LAFARGE conveyor and before the entrance to the Kelleys Island Ferry. Parents will turn left into the city lot and then exit by the Dairy Dock.

# Erie County Junior 4-H Camp at Kelleys Island

## WHAT TO BRING:

*Put your name on everything possible with a permanent laundry marker.*

- 4-H COVID Waiver (submit the morning of camp at check-in)
- Casual clothes for three to four days.
- Two pairs of good walking shoes (no new shoes, please)  
**NOTE:** There are several camp activities where sandals or flip flops should NOT be worn.
- Swimsuit and towel
- Prescription medication in its original drugstore container with its original prescription label (to be turned-in to nurse at the boat dock)
- Raincoat/poncho, sweater, sweatshirt for cold, wet weather.
- Insect repellent, sunscreen, and chapstick.
- Toothbrush, deodorant, soap, comb, washcloth, towels, and flip flops for the shower. Label your items with your name.
- Small plastic pail or cosmetic bag to carry personal items to the shower.
- Sleeping bag OR two blankets and sheets (it can get chilly at night), and pillow. **NOTE:** Lots of people pack their sleeping bag/pillow in black garbage bags. If you do, we recommend you put a distinctive mark on your bag (duct tape with your name on the tape, etc.).
- Flashlight and batteries.
- Plastic garbage bag for dry dirty clothes and possibly another for wet clothes.
- Cabin decorations for our *Wanted in the Wild West* theme. There will be a cabin decorating contest!
- Glow-in-the-dark necklaces, clothing, etc. for our '**glow dance**' on Sunday night!
- Lots of spirit and energy!!!

Optional:

- A SMALL amount of money for snacks at the canteen/camp store. Snacks and pop cost approximately .75 - \$1.00 each. **NOTE:** Youth will receive an Erie County 4-H Camp t-shirt as part of their registration fee.

**DO NOT BRING:** Cell phones, iPods, iPads, Apple watch or similar, eReaders, pagers, two-way radios, CD players/mp3 players, shaving cream, matches, fireworks, a lot of money, an expensive camera, alcoholic beverages, drugs, weapons – including pocket knives, balloons and squirt guns (no water fights) etc...
